

Vto Overview

Vto is a Mid Office Client Trip Management System which exports Client Travel Account financial data to MYOB® accounting systems to minimise back office data processing.

Vto is available as a user driven system which requires consultants to enter Client Profile and sector details manually or download* Client profiles and sector by sector details from their Amadeus, Galileo or Sabre CRS/GDS.

Vto allows all forms of receipting Customer Payments, Cash, Cheque, Credit Card, EFTPOS and CCCF and payments to Suppliers via Cheque, CCCF, Money Direct, eNett, Tias Tips or Your Credit Card.

Vto generates a full range of management reports including;

- Client Reports
- Debtor Reports
- Creditor Reports
- Supplier Reports
- Turnover Reports
- Accounting Reports
- Trip Balance Reports
- TCF Summary Report
- Client Trip Status Report

Vto FAQ's

Q: Does Vto have an integrated Back Office System?

A: No – Financial data from Vto is exported to MYOB® BusinessBasics, Accounting v11 or higher.

Q: Does Vto interface directly with our current GDS System?

A: Yes, this feature is now available to Amadeus & Sabre clients

Q: What is the annual support cost associated with Vto?

A: Annual support fees are included in the monthly user fees – any onsite fees will be charged at our standard hourly rate.

Vto controls support costs via our on board “Live Support” system, this is a text based module and provides for an email option in the event the Live Support option is off Line.

Q: How much should I budget for Upgrades to new versions of Vto?

A: All upgrades are included in monthly user fees. All Upgrades are and will continue to be User Driven

Q: Does it matter which version of Windows® I have installed on my systems?

A: No, However, Vto performs best under either Windows® 2000 or Windows® XP with screen resolutions set to a minimum of 1024x768(1280x1024 is better)
